So that I can review my selected items and make
any necessary adjustments."

Tasks Brake Down

1. UI Design
2. Backend Development - Shopping Cart Functionality
3. Frontend Development - Shopping Cart Integration
4. Testing
5. Documentation

UI Design

- Task: Create wireframes for the shopping cart page.
- Task: Design the user interface for adding, removing, and editing items in the shopping cart.

Backend Development - Shopping Cart Functionality

- Task: Implement the backend logic to retrieve and display the items in the shopping cart.
- Task: Develop the functionality to update the quantity and remove items from the shopping cart.

Frontend Development - Shopping Cart Integration

- Task: Integrate the designed UI components with the backend shopping cart functionality.
- Task: Implement the necessary frontend logic for dynamic updates to the shopping cart without requiring a full page reload.

Testing

- Task: Write unit tests for the backend shopping cart functionality to ensure it works as expected.
- Task: Conduct usability testing to ensure a smooth and intuitive user experience on the shopping cart page.
